

# SWALLOWING WHALE

If you complete this activity, log another hour of reading in Read City USA's 2022 reading voyage, Oceans of Possibilities. Together, Knox County will read one million hours!

Color and cut out the whale's parts. (You might want to color the reverse side of the body, which will be "inside" the whale.) Roll the body into a cone shape and fasten. (It will not form a complete point.) With the seam to the bottom, slightly flatten and then fold up the small end of the cone on the dotted

line. Glue the tail to the tab. Add eyes and fins. Roll your spout into a small, pointy cone and fasten. Cut small slits in the top, about half way down, to create the water spout! Poke a small hole where indicated on top of the whale, and insert the spout. (You may need to add some glue).
