Step 1

Select a title from the electronic bookshelf. For this example, we are using *Knots: The Complete Visual Guide*.



Step 2

Use volume selectors and expand arrows to see all volumes and entries, then select an entry.

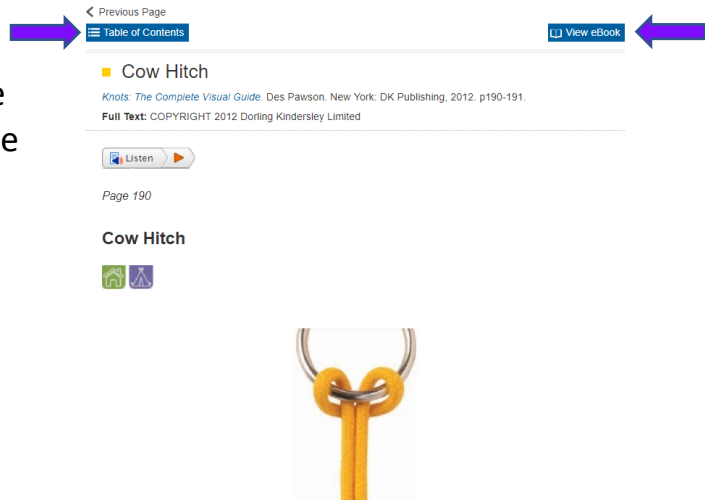
