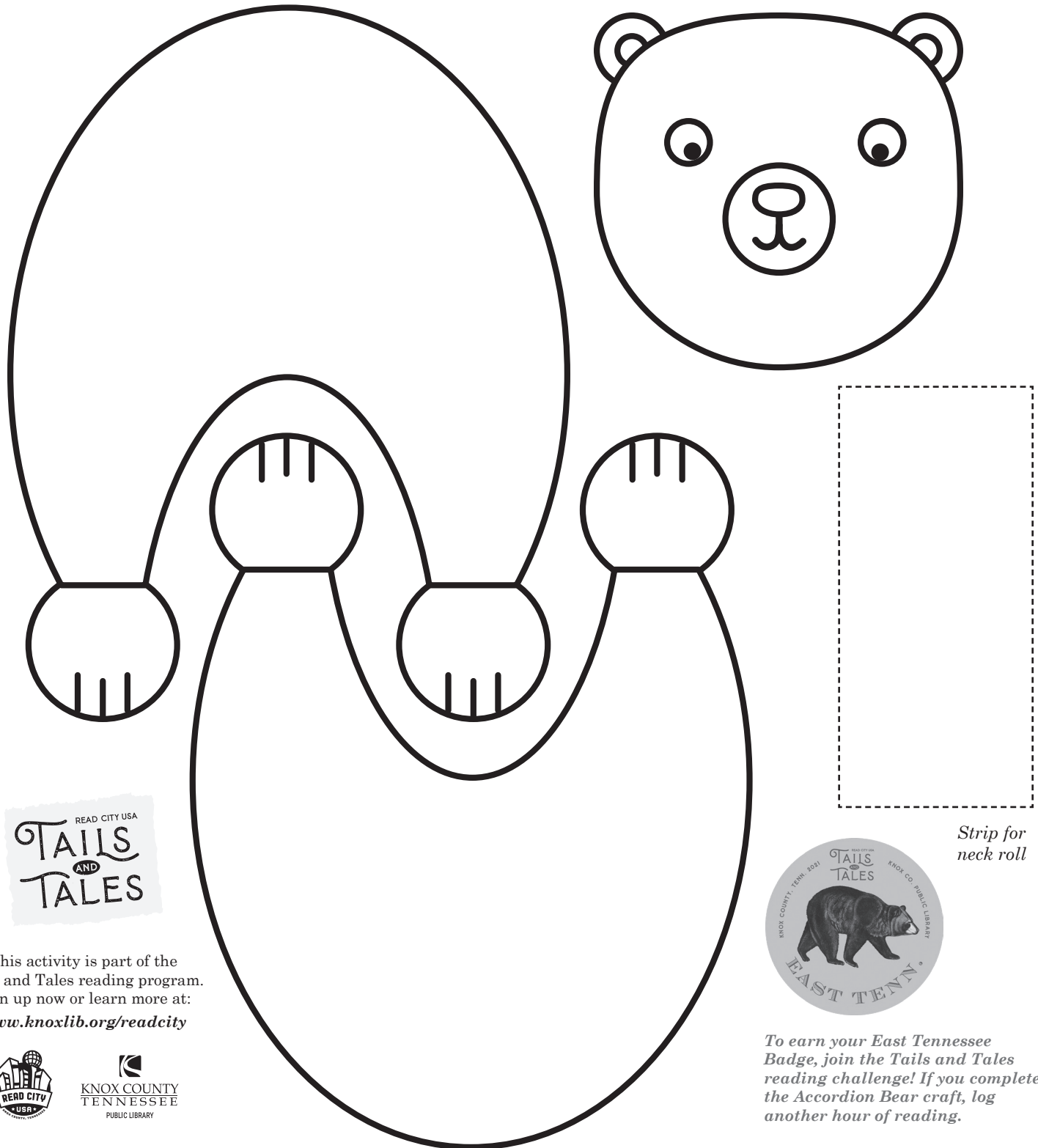
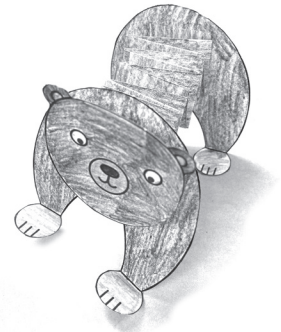
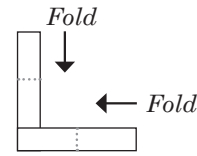


# Accordion Black Bear

Color and cut out your bear head, legs, and strips for the accordion body (following page). *Hint: Color both sides of the accordion.* Glue (or tape) two strips together to make a long strip, then repeat with remaining strips. Overlap the corners of the two long strips, at right angles, and glue together. Then fold the bottom strip over the top and fold the other strip over that. Repeat until no more strip is available, then secure both ends of the accordion. Glue front and back of bear to accordion. Make a roll from the neck strip and glue. Glue to front of bear, then glue head to neck.
